MY GRANDPARENTS' CHILDHOOD

My grandmother's usual day started early in the morning. She woke up and got up. Then she got dressed and went to school in Ig. She walked to school 3 kilometers every day. In winter she walked across the field, because the route was shorter there. She had only one school-bag for eight years. She had a wooden pencil-case. Later she sewed a new pencil-case by herself. She had Maths, Slovene, Natural Science and Art. She had English from the fifth grade on. She had Physics and Chemistry in the seventh and the eighth grade. After school she helped her parents. She played outside with her brother and sister. She went inside in the evening and did her homework. Then she ate her dinner and went to bed. They went to church every Sunday morning. She lived in a village Matena near Ig. She lived on a farm. She went out in the morning at the weekend. She went to feed the cows, hens and a pig in the morning. Then she went to the kitchen and ate breakfast. She usually ate žganci, polenta, mush or an egg and drank white coffee or milk. After breakfast she and her brother and sister went out. They played hide and seek, rotten egg or hopscotch outside. They didn't have a lot of toys. Then she went inside and she helped her mum cook lunch. They ate meat once or twice a week, usually on Sundays. They had potatoes, soup, salad or pancakes for lunch. She

sometimes swept the yard in front of the house. She and her family lived in one room. She had a doll and some wooden toys. Sometimes she brought something to her neighbours and she got some money. She didn't have a TV or a radio. She didn't have a bike, but her older sister and brother had them. They didn't have a bathroom. They had a toilet inside the house. This was my grandmother's childhood.
